Ryan started his fire service career in 2001 as a volunteer firefighter for Madera County Fire. In 2003 he accepted a Firefighter 1 position in the Madera–Mariposa– Merced Unit. While in MMU he worked as a Fire Apparatus Engineer in Schedule A, Fire Captain in the Emergency Command Center and Fire Captain in Schedule B. In 2021 Ryan accepted a position as the Emergency Command Center Battalion Chief in the Tuolumne - Calaveras Unit. In 2023 Ryan promoted to Assistant Chief of Administration in the Tuolumne – Calaveras Unit which is his current assignment.

Ryan started filling ICS roles in 2014 in MMU as part of the local Unit’s Incident Support Program working in the Planning Section. In 2015 he joined CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 5 as a Resource Unit Leader. In 2018 Ryan moved over to the Situation Unit as a Situation Unit Trainee and was qualified the following year. In 2020 he moved up to Planning Section Chief Trainee where he became qualified and now fulfills the role of Planning Section Chief on IMT 5.

Previous cadre assignments have been Resource Unit Leader and Situation Unit Leader. Ryan is currently on the Planning Section Chief, C-420 (Command and General Staff), and AAIM (Advanced All-Hazards Incident Management) cadres. He also teaches the Planning Technical Specialist class held in the Tuolumne-Calaveras Unit.
