Transitioning to the Bureau of Land Management in 1998, Tiffany served as a Range Aid Firefighter before joining CAL FIRE in 2000 as a Firefighter I in the Lassen Modoc Unit. Her dedication and proficiency led to her promotion to Engineer in 2003. Seeking diverse experiences, Tiffany ventured to the Oregon Division of Forestry in 2005, where she honed her skills as a Forest Officer.

In 2006, Tiffany assumed the role of Engine Boss with the Nevada Division of Forestry. Reinstating to CAL FIRE in 2007, she embarked on a journey of advancement, climbing through the ranks from Firefighter I to Fire Captain. Transferring to the Nevada Yuba Placer Unit, she adeptly balanced field and staff assignments, showcasing her leadership prowess.

Since 2019, Tiffany has played a pivotal role in the NEU Training Bureau as a Fire Captain, contributing to the development of aspiring firefighters. Her exemplary service culminated in her promotion to Battalion Chief in NEU in 2022, followed by a transfer to the North Division Battalion Chief role. In her current capacity, she oversees the Unit Hired Equipment Program and HFEO program, demonstrating her commitment to operational excellence.

Tiffany's involvement with Incident Management Teams (IMTs) dates back to 2002, primarily in the Finance Section. As a Type I Finance Section Chief, she has been an indispensable asset to CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 5 since 2008, holding key positions such as EQTS, TIME, and FSC. Additionally, she serves as the Finance Section Chief on the Sacramento Regional Type III Incident Management Team, contributing her expertise to incident-related finance disciplines.

Guard. She also shares her knowledge and experience as a certified State Fire Marshal Instructor.
